Deployment Highlights

- First-ever BMX Supercross World Cup event to be held in Canada;
- 3rd party license agreement between [Cycling BC](#) and PHSA for use of the MMU facility (cost recovery model);
- Milestone collaboration between the PHSA MMU, UBC Mass Gathering Interest Group, BC Ambulance Service, and UCI BMX International Medical leadership teams;
- Demonstrated ability for the MMU to provide a range of care from first-aid through emergency level-care at a high-risk sporting event on the international competition stage; and
- Unique educational opportunity for members of the MMU, BCAS, and clinicians from across the Lower Mainland to learn about the provision of BMX track-side care and protocols for removal of specific BMX safety equipment.
