- Provided critical and surgical care capability at the Whistler Athlete's Village during the 2010 Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games
- Staffed by four teams of 25 (100 total) clinicians from across Canada
- Saw 43 patients, and 13 ambulance transfers
- Daily simulation training took place when patients were not in the unit
