Deployment Highlights

- Served as temporary emergency department for the Pemberton Health Centre , serving the town of Pemberton and surrounding area;
- Allowed for patient care to be delivered as usual, while allowing important renovations to take place within the fixed facility;
- MMU's longest deployment to date since the Olympics, and first time to hook into shore power; and
- First ever baby born in the MMU, with a total of five births by the end of the deployment.
